## Beyond Next Steps Training Programme

**Beyond Next Steps** is a training programme designed specifically for those who have already completed a minimum of a 60 hours TA training. This might be the Next Steps programme or a similar Foundation Year programme with another qualified TA trainer.

The course content will contribute to the requirements for the newly launched IDTA professional qualifications in Developmental TA. In addition, the programme also contributes to the training requirements for the international Certificate in Transactional Analysis (CTA).

Individuals are welcome to join the group even if they are not currently intending to accredit their TA study.

It is anticipated that the course group will have stable membership throughout the year - people are encouraged to contract for the full programme.

In total, the programme will provide approximately 70 hours training time spread across 11 days, the three is September of which will be a residential event
